RIRs active in WSIS (World Summit on Information Society) under **NRO** umbrella

- Beginning of current Multi-stakeholder approach to Internet Governance
- Established the Technical Community as a legitimate stakeholder (in addition to Civil Society, Business)
- Continue to cooperate with Government and partners (ISOC, ICANN, IETF...) in areas of common interest.

 - Typically 40+ government representatives from 15+ countries
- Future meetings typically Feb/Sept each year.

- Renewal of IGF for five years (involves UN)
- Increased outreach to ITU
- Coordinate community position via Cooperation Working Group and Roundtables.
- Enhance relations with Governments in RIPE NCC service region.
- Continue outreach to all WSIS partners, to understand what is important
- Strengthen liaison via RIPE NCC Legal Team
- Identify further opportunities for LEA and anti-abuse co-operation.
