COVID-19 info

What are the rules for passengers entering Portugal?

All passengers, whether national or foreign citizens, on arrival in Portugal must:

- Present proof of a **negative COVID-19 test result**, performed within the last **72 hours before** boarding, except for children under 24 months of age.
 - Comply with **isolation for 14 days**, coming from South Africa, Brazil, India or from countries with an incidence rate equal to or greater than 500 cases per 100,000 inhabitants in the last 14 days, whether by air, land, or sea. Isolation does not apply to passengers on essential travel and whose length of stay in the national territory, certified by a return ticket, does not exceed 48 hours.
- The list of countries meeting these criteria is reviewed and updated every 15 days.

Measures are still in place throughout Portugal to control the spread of the virus.

There remains an ongoing civic duty to remain at home, whenever possible, and to observe the rules on social distancing when in public.

General behavior guidelines and rules that all people must adopt are the following:

- Keep a **social distance** of 2 meters.
- Use a **mask**, or **face covering**, in enclosed spaces, and outdoors, where a 2 m distance cannot be maintained.
- **Wash your hands** regularly.
- **Respiratory** etiquette.

Your temperature can be taken on access to workplaces, healthcare facilities, and other enclosed spaces, as determined by the health authorities.

You can also be asked to provide a negative COVID-19 test.

You can be fined if you breach the regulations.
