**Short Biography:**

He is the **Chief Frequency Officer** in the CTO office of the Alcatel-Lucent, Carrier Group/Wireless Technologies, based in Vélizy, France.

He received his Ph.D in speech coding for mobile communications from University of Technology, Loughborough, UK.

After his first experiences (1982-1988) at Group Philips (TRT) in Paris, he joined Alcatel-Lucent's R&I department in April 1988 and managed leading technical European projects which led to current UMTS and ATM wireless technologies.

Since 1998, he is the Chief Frequency Officer, first at Paris based Headquarter (1998-2000) and then, in Vélizy for the CTO office of the Wireless Technologies. Moreover, he is the Alcatel-Lucent's lead representative in several international groups such as ITU-R, the UMTS Forum/ Spectrum Group, Mobile TV Group, European based ECC/PT1, ECC/TG4 Groups related to IMT and digital dividend issues, respectively. Moreover, during 2000-2005, he served as the Director of the Board for 3G Patents Platform Partnership (3G3P).

He has been an Alcatel-Lucent Technical Academy member since 2001 and also a senior member of IEEE since 1989 and is very active in IEEE organizations and has authored/co-authored around 100 publications in IEEE and other internationally well-known magazines as well as in conference proceedings including 20 key notes speeches.
