Matthew Conway is the Director of Operations for the Spectrum Policy Group in Ofcom, the UK's regulatory authority for communications. He is responsible for the award of the digital dividend—the spectrum freed up by digital switchover—and for spectrum policy for the London 2012 Olympic Games and Paralympic Games. He also heads the Group's corporate functions as well as projects to improve information about, and innovation in, spectrum use.

Previously, Matthew was the Director of Trade Operations in the UK Government's Department of Trade and Industry. There he was responsible for promoting and seeking international compliance with global trade rules, for pursuing access to overseas markets for UK business and for aspects of international corporate social responsibility. He also had cross-cutting trade-policy responsibility for China and the Departmental lead responsibility for bribery and corruption. Matthew has also been Projects Director for School Sport and Coaching in the Department for Culture, Media and Sport and the Department for Education and Skills, Head of European Communications Policy in the Department of Trade and Industry, Head of the International Section in the Office of Telecommunications and Head of the Royal Mint Review in Her Majesty's Treasury, where he held other posts after beginning his Civil Service career as a graduate entrant in the Department of Transport.
