Profile

After a university degree in Electrical Engineering at the University of the Federal Armed Forces, Germany, Mr. Ewers has been working continuously since 1992 in the area of national and international spectrum regulation on different levels. Nowadays he is the head of section for international affairs and utilization concepts in the Federal Network Agency, Germany. Having started in the beginning of his career with frequency coordination issues his responsibilities have been broadened to strategic frequency utilization concepts and the transposition of those to the international level of CEPT, EU and ITU. Doing this and having been active in the preparation of several WRC's Mr. Ewers participated in a number of international Groups as Head of the German Delegation. He has also chaired several groups and subgroups on the ITU and CEPT level. The activities in ITU focused on Study Group 5 for which he coordinates all German activities on the national level. Between 2003 and beginning of 2008 Mr. Ewers has been the Chairman of a ITU-R Working Party and is still Vice Chairman of ITU-R SG5.

After participating in several meetings of the CEPT Electronic Communications Committee (ECC) and its subordinate groups Mr. Ewers has been appointed Chairman of the ECC in December 2007.
