2. Main areas of responsibility :

Under the supervision of the Head of Unit:

- Process/project manager for Rail transport statistics which is a process governed by Regulation (EC) No 91/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council; in the next years the Regulation is expected to evolve under several aspects: interpretation of definitions (transit for example), timeliness of data transmissions, collection of data on high-speed train traffic, discontinuation of the data collection related to accident statistics...
- Process/project manager for Regional transport statistics (infrastructures, stocks of vehicles, accidents); this is a process in which the data are collected from a web questionnaire on the one hand, extracted from the legal data collections of certain transport modes on the other hand.

3. Main qualifications :

We are looking for a skilled head of project, if possible experienced in statistics and/or transport policies; advanced user of office automation and information technology applications and tools; able to work on legal matters; able to coordinate processes to which +/- 30 countries contribute at quarterly / semester / annual / 5-year intervals, according to the data collections.

4. Languages:

EN (both spoken and written) is mandatory. FR is an additional asset.
