5.XXX Stations in the amateur service using frequencies in this band shall not exceed a maximum radiated power of 1 W (e.r.p.) and shall not cause harmful interference to stations of the radionavigation service operating in countries listed in provision 5.67. (WRC-07)

Reasons: *A secondary allocation to the amateur service in the frequency band 135.7-137.8 kHz would harmonize on a worldwide basis the use of this band.*
