Since July 1st 2018 he is the CEO of aicep Global Parques - Gestão de Áreas Empresariais e Serviços, S. A., a Portuguese SOE under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, responsible for managing industrial and logistics usage government land and business parks, namely at the Sines Port, Logistics and Industrial Complex – Portugal’s main energy and digital transitions hub.

He previously served as Economic and Commercial Affairs Consul of Portugal in San Francisco and before that Shanghai, and with ANACOM (Portuguese communications NRA) represented Portugal at the International Telecommunications Union (Geneva, UN); and as a shareholder at Inmarsat (London); Eutelsat (Paris) and Intelsat-ITSO (Washington, D.C.). While at the Portuguese Trade & Investment Agency, he worked at the "Context Costs and National Interest Projects Division" and the "SME Division" in Lisbon, as well as the Office in Madrid.

He held several positions at the Portuguese Administration, such as Director General of EU funding at the Ministry of Interior and Chief of Staff of the Minister of Justice.
