Luís Gaspar holds an Economics degree from Universidade Nova de Lisboa and earned a master's degree in the same area at SOAS – University of London. In 2005, he worked in marketing at Google in Dublin, and then at the Portuguese Embassy in the United Kingdom, at AICEP, where he was responsible for promoting various Portuguese product lines in the UK market.

In 2008, Luís returned to Portugal and joined ANACOM, working on regulation in the fixed and mobile telephony markets. Between 2014 and 2018, he worked at OFCOM, the UK communications regulator, where he was responsible for the design of frequency auctions, completing the 5G auction (2.3/3.4 GHz) in early 2018.

In mid-2018, he started working at Autoridade da Concorrência (Portuguese Competition Authority) as a Competition Specialist in the Department of Restrictive Practices, before returning to ANACOM in September 2020.
