Holding a licentiate's degree in legal sciences from the Faculty of Law of the Bucharest University and a *Maîtrise* in European Law from University Paris I – Panthéon Sorbonne, Alexandrina Hirtan has been vice-president of the Romanian telecom regulator (now the National Regulatory Authority for Communications and Information Technology, or ANRCTI) since the institution was originally established, in 2002. In December 2006, she was reconfirmed in this position for a five years mandate.

She oversees the ANRCTI strategic and operational planning processes, in particular the design of the regulatory strategy for the electronic communications sector, the execution of the annual activity programmes of ANRCTI and the regulatory decision-making process, directly coordinating ANRCTI's legal and economic regulatory affairs departments. Alexandrina Hirtan also coordinates ANRCTI's international relations and the dialogue with the European Commission.

Previously, as Secretary of State for European Integration and International Affairs within the Romanian Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Alexandrina Hirtan coordinated the national transposition of the new EU regulatory framework for electronic communications and Romania's accession negotiations with the EU on the telecoms chapter.
