The case handler is responsible for preparing draft Commission decisions, preparing negotiations with companies and ensuring that procedures are correctly applied.

The unit concerned deals with merger control in financial services and health-related markets. The unit's staff is also called on to work in merger teams in other sectors, and eventually in antitrust case teams.

This involves individual work as well as a member of case teams, and regular contacts with companies and their legal representatives, contacts with other DG Competition Directorates and with other Commission services.
- * contributing to the development of competition policy, for instance by participating in working groups and preparing reports.
- * preparing briefings and speeches for the Commissioner and the Director-General responsible for competition policy;
- * market monitoring in the sectors falling within the Unit's remit, with a view to detecting anticompetitive conducts and proposing possible ex-officio investigations.
- * analysing and clarifying competition issues in the context of informal contacts with companies and their legal representatives, e.g. in the context of informal complaints
- * preparing replies to parliamentary questions and questions from undertakings and citizens relating to competition policy.

The case-officer will be primarily responsible for anti-trust cases, in particular cartels and cases of abuse of a dominant position, as well as to a lesser extent for merger cases in the sectors falling within the responsibilities of Directorate E.

2. Main areas of responsibility :

The unit "Forecasts and economic situation" is composed of a team of eight economists and two statistical assistants. The unit is responsible for monitoring and analyzing, on a regular basis, macroeconomic developments in the euro-area and the EU as a whole. It is also responsible for coordinating both the bi-annual macro-economic and the interim forecasts of the European Commission.

The main areas of responsibility of the seconded national expert would be to contribute to the preparation, further improvements in and production of the bi-annual macroeconomic forecast; assess at the euro-area and EU levels the impact of country-specific developments in close co-operation with colleagues in, especially, the Directorates F and G (Economies of the Member States); draft notes on specific economic issues and analyze documents/reports/forecasts of international institutions (mainly the ECB, IMF and OECD). The function also offers scope for research in particular topics such as euro-area business cycles, growth differences and/or macro-economic adjustment in the euro area, determinants of euro-area domestic demand.

3. Main qualifications :

The seconded national expert should have a university degree in economics. A sound level of competence in economic analysis and, in particular, experience in the area of applied macroeconomics and macro-economic policy analysis is required. Knowledge of appropriate methodologies for applied econometric analysis and experience in the area of forecasting would be desirable.
