2. Main areas of responsibility :

The unit, which is in charge of enforcing antitrust policy in the telecommunications sector is looking for an experienced lawyer, economist, or engineer who, by virtue of his/her background, is able to deal with legal and economic matters and is able to conduct cost analyses. Knowledge of recent economic and legal developments in competition matters and of the relevant case-law of the European Court of Justice in the field and/or sectors in question will be an advantage. He/she will deal with complaints and/or own-initiative procedures under Art. 101 and 102 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU) as well as infringement procedures against Member States for non-respect of "the competition directive" and Article 106 of the TFEU.

The case-handler holds the key responsibility from the initial investigation until the final decision. The work involves frequent contacts with companies and their legal and economic advisers. Case-handlers are also expected to contribute to general discussions within the unit concerning the development of competition policy in the sectors concerned.

3. Main qualifications :

Candidates should ideally be lawyers, economists, or engineers, and should have significant knowledge/experience of applying anti-trust rules and/or telecoms regulation.
