Bernd Langeheine has been the Director for e-Communications Policy at the European Commission's Information Society and Media DG since 1 July 2002.

Before that he headed the General Policy unit in the European Commission's DG Competition for three years. From January 1996 to June 1999, he was in charge of the Trade Section in the Washington Delegation of the European Commission. From 1990-1996, Mr. Langeheine was a Member of the Commission's Legal Service and before that, he spent three years as law clerk (référéndaire) at the European Court of Justice. From 1983 to 1987, he worked in the Trade Policy Division of the Commission's DG for External Relations.

Mr. Langeheine spent the academic year 1993/94 as an EU Fellow at the Business School of the University of Washington in Seattle, Wash. He studied law and political science at the Universities of Hamburg and Berlin and holds a Ph. D. in law.
