Peter Rodford is Head of the European Commission unit responsible for compliance with EU electronic communications regulation. His remit includes the roaming regulation, coordinating infringement proceedings against Member States relating to the e-communications directives, and the report to the Council and European Parliament on their implementation. He is scheduled to take up the post of head of the e-communications regulatory policy unit, dealing with the negotiation of the regulatory framework, in March 2008.

He has been a member of the Commission's staff since 1974, and has worked in the Legal Service, the External Affairs Directorate General, and as a member of the cabinet of Commissioner Peter M. Schmidhuber, where he was responsible for telecoms liberalisation and external affairs.

He is the author, with Professor Paul Nihoul, of "EU Electronic Communications Law", published by Oxford University Press in 2004. He is a contributor to the forthcoming "Oxford Encyclopaedia of European Community Law" (Oxford University Press), and is visiting professor at the College of Europe, Bruges.
